(WEST PAKISTAN AMENDMENT)
ORDINANCE, 1966

(W. P. Ordinance VII of 1966)

[31stMarch, 1966]

An Ordinance to amend the Administrator- General's Act, 1913, in its application to the Province of West Pakistan.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Administrator-General's Act, 1913, in its application to the Province of West Pakistan, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

AND WHEREAS the Provincial Assembly of West Pakistan is not in session and the Governor of West Pakistan is satisfied that circumstances exist which render immediate legislation necessary;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred on him under clause (1) of Article 79 of the Constitution', the Governor of West Pakistan is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:—

I. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Administrator-General's (West Pakistan Amendment) Ordinance, 1966.

(2) It extends to the whole of the Province of West Pakistan, except the Tribal Areas.

(3) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Administrator-General's Act, 1913, in its application to the Province of West Pakistan, in section 10, between the words "East Pakistan" and the comma and words "the Court" the words, "or the High Court of West Pakistan" shall

be inserted.

This Ord. was promulgated by the Governor of West Pakistan on 29" March, 1966; approved by the Provincial Assembly of West Pakistan on 8" June, 1966, under clause (3) of Article 79 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan 1961; and published in the West Pakistan Gazette (Extraordinary), dated 8" June, 1966, pages 1629-30.
