Preamble. WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Baluchistan Provincial Council Ordinance; 1980 (VII of 1980), in the manner hereinafter appearing;

_. AND! WHEREAS, the Governor is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it :-necessary to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 128 of the Constitution, read with Article 2 of the Provisional Constitution Order, 1981 (C.M.L.A. Order No.1 of 1981), the Governor of Baluchistan is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

Short. title | 1, (1) This Ordinance may be called the Baluchistan Provincial Council and commencement, (Amendment). Ordinance, 1984, .

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2: In the Baluchistan Provincial Council Ordinance, 1980 (VII of 1980), the fullstop appearing at the end of clause (iv) of sub-section (2) of section. § shall be replaced by a colon, and thereafter the following proviso: shall be added, namely — :

Amendment of
section 6 of

“Provided that no order of removal shall be passed against any

member unless he has been given opportunity of showing ‘cause and of being heard.”
