No. CEO(S&GAD)1-10/Rule/2021/1-55. In exercise of the powers conferred by rule 45 of the Fundamental Rules 1922, the Government of Balochistan is pleased to make the following amendments in the Residential Accommodation at Quetta (Procedure for Allotment) Rules, 2009 namely:-

In the aforesaid rule in rule 11, for sub rule (4), the following shall be substituted:-

“(4) (a) The allottees on their retirement will be entitled to have

their allotments transferred in the names of their real son / daughter or husband/ wife, if he / she belong to eligible department and serving in basic pay scale equivalent or higher than required for the allotment. In case, the real son/ daughter or husband/ wife is serving in a lower basic pay scale, he or she shall be entertained with accommodation admissible to officers/ officials of the same basic pay scale. The retiring government servant should apply for such allotment within a period of one year before his /her retirement.

However, if he/ she does not apply within one year before retirement it shall be considered the option is forgone and it is the responsibility of Civil Estate Officer to process/ allot accommodation according to his/ her scale as per application with prior approval of committee in case of receipt of such application.

The officer/ official after retirement can not retain the house for more than 6 months if his/ her legal heir has no entitlement for that category and have to vacate after expiry of retention period.”
