(SECURITY) ACT, 2009

An Act to provide security of shops and
establishments.

WHEREAS, it is expedient to provide for security of
shops and establishments and for matters connected therewith or
incidental thereto;

It is hereby enacted as follows: -

1. (1) This Act may be called the Balochistan Shops
and Establishments (Security) Act, 2009.

(2) It extends to the whole of Province of
Balochistan except the Tribal Areas.

(3) It shall come into force at once.

2. In this Act, unless there is anything repugnant in the
subject or context: -

(a) "Act" means the Balochistan Shops and
Establishments (Security) Act, 2009;

(b) "Establishment" means and includes: -

(i) a bank, a money changer or a
financial institution; and

(ii) any office, firm,
institution, industrial unit,
undertaking, shop or premises
which undertakes any business,
trade, manufacture, calling, service,

employment or occupation; and

company,

(c) "Government" means the Government of Balochistan.

3. |The Government may, by order, provide for the regulation of and enforcement of measures for the security of the property

and persons connected with an Establishment.

4. If any person contravenes any order made under this Act, he shall be punished with imprisonment which may extend to one month or with fine which may extend to fifteen thousand rupees or with both and if the offence continues, the Establishment may be kept sealed till such time the order is complied with.

5. The Government may make rules to give effect to the provisions of this Act.
