An Act to requisition the services of Charge Nurses.

Preamble. WHEREAS it is expedient to secure the services of  
Charge Nurses for the Province of Baluchistan;

It is hereby enacted as follows: —

Short title, extent 1. (1) This Act may be called the Baluchistan Charge  
and Nurses (Compulsory Service) Act, 1975.

t. (2) It shall come into force at once.

(3) It shall apply to the Province of Baluchistan  
except the Tribal Areas.

Definitions. 2. (1) In this Act, unless there is anything repugnant, in  
the subject or context: —

(i) "Government" means the Government of  
Baluchistan;

(ii) "Charge Nurse" means a woman who has  
qualified the Charge Nurse Examination  
conducted by the West Pakistan Nursing  
Service Council, Lahore/Punjab Nursing  
Services Council, Lahore, Nursing  
Examination Board, Baluchistan, Quetta  
at the expense and quota of Government

of Baluchistan.

Requisition of 3. Notwithstanding anything contained in any other Law, a  
Service. Charge Nurse shall be liable to serve the Province of  
Baluchistan for a period of at least three years, if so required by

Government: —

(a) if she has qualified as such on or after the first  
day of July, 1970, but before the commencement

of this Act, within one year of the day of  
commencement of this Act;

(b) if she qualifies after the commencement of this  
Act, within one year of her qualifying.

4. Whoever disobeys the order of Government with respect  
to the requisitioning of her service or in any other manner  
defies the notice issued by the Government, shall suffer  
imprisonment for two years and shall also be liable to fine  
which may extend to five thousand rupees.

5. No Court shall take cognizance of an offence under this  
Act, except on complaint by the Government or an officer  
authorised in this behalf by the Government and on the  
recommendation of the Committee constituted by the  
Government for the purpose.

6. Without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing  
provisions the Government may make rules to carry out the  
provisions of this Act.
