WHEREAS. it is expedient further to amend the Balochistan
Coastal Development Authority Act, 1998, in the manner hereinafter
appearing;

AND WHEREAS, the Governor of Balochistan is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action:

NOW THEREFORE, in pursuance of Article 4 of the Provisional Constitution (Amendment) Order, 1999 (Chief executive's Order No. 9 of 1999), and in exercise of all powers enabling him that behalf, the Governor of Balochistan is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

Ls (1) This Ordinance may be called the Balochistan Coastal Development Authority (Second Amendment) Ordinance, 2001.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Balochistan Coastal Development Authority Act, 1998, hereinafter referred to as the said Act, for clause (fa) of Section 2, the following shall be substituted:-

“(fay’ Director General” means the Director General of the Authority;

3. In the said Act, in Section 6, for the words “Managing Director” wherever occurring the words “Director General” shall be substituted. ;
