BALUCHISTAN ORDINANCE NO. X OF 1981.

THE BALUCHISTAN EDUCATION PROJECTS (IMPLEMENTATION AND REGULATION) ORDINANCE, 1981.

ORDINANCE

to provide for regulation of the planning and construction of buildings, and purchase and provision of facilities, equipments and furniture for Educational Institutions and maintenance of record in connection with implementation of Education Project in the Province of Baluchistan.

WHEREAS it is expedient to regulate the plating, preparation of estimates for, according technical and administrative approval thereto and construction of buildings, the provision of facilities and purchase of equipments and furniture for the Educational Institutions in the Province of Baluchistan ;

AND WHEREAS the Governor is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of July, 1977, read with the Laws (Continuance in Force) Order, 1977, (CMLA Order No. 1 of 1977), and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the Governor of Baluchistan is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:—

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Baluchistan Education Projects (Implementation and Regulation) Ordinance, 1981.

(2) It shall come into force at once,

(3) It shall apply to such areas and/or Projects as the Government may by Notification specify.

2. Nothing contained in any other law for the time being in force shall apply to any matter regulated by this Ordinance and rules made thereunder, unless the context otherwise requires.

3. In this Ordinance, unless otherwise repugnant in the subject or context:

(8) "Architect" means the architect appointed by the Project Committee;

(o) "Consultants" means the Consultants appointed by the Project Committee; =

(c) "Department" means a Department of the Government of Baluchistan;

(d) "Government" means the Government of Baluchistan, in the appropriate Department;

(e) "Project Director" means the Project Director appointed by the Government under section 4;

(f) "Project Engineer" means the Engineer appointed by the Government under section 4;

(g) "Prescribed" means prescribed by the Rules made under this Ordinance;

(h) "Project Committee" means the Committee appointed by the Government under section 5;

(j) "Secretary "means the Secretary to the Government of Baluchistan in appropriate Department ;

(k) "Superintending Engineer \*" means the Engineer appointed by the Government under section 4. é

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Rules.

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4. (1) The Government may, by notifications appoint any officer to act as Project Director, Project Engineer and Superintendent Engineer in connection with the implementation of an Education Project to which this Ordinance is made applicable .

(2) The Government may fix the pay, allowances and remunerations of the officers appointed under sub-section (1),

(3) The Government may, assign such duties and functions to the officers, appointed under sub-section (1), as may be prescribed.

5. (1) The Government may, by notification constitute a Project Committee, consisting of not more than seven members, for the of supervising the implementation of an Education Project and regulating the procedure for maintaining record of various agencies in respect of the activities relating to the Project, to which this Ordinance is made applicable.

(2) The Government may, assign such functions and powers to the Project Committee as may be prescribed.

(3) One of the members shall be appointed as Chairman of the Project Committee.

(4) The Project Director shall be member/convenor of the Project Committee.

(5) The Government may fix such remunerations for the members of the Project Committee as it may deem fit.

6. (1) The Government may make Rules consistent with the Provisions of this Ordinance to carry out the purposes of this Ordinance.

(2) In particular and without prejudice to the generality of foregoing powers, rules may provide for:-

(a) The terms and condition of employment of Architects, Consultants and technical assistance;

(b) The payment to the Architects, Consultants and Technical assistants.

(c) Organization of the Project Office of Implementation Unit.

(d) The duties and responsibilities of the Project Director, Superintending Engineer, Project Engineer and any other official employed for the purpose of this Ordinance,

(e) Preparation, scrutinising and approval of estimates, Tender Docu-

ments, Drawings, Plans.

(f) Floating and approval of Tender and issue of Work Orders.

(2) Recording of measurements and preparing of bills for work done, supplies made or service rendered.

(h) Checking of bills and payment thereof .

(j) Withdrawal of funds from the Treasury.

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(k) Ian expenditure, ma' accounts, prescri-

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- (1) The submission of returns and statements,
- (m) The procurement of stores, equipments, furnitures and supplies.
- (n) The conduct of audit of the accounts.
