definitions, 2. In this Act, unless there is anything repugnant, in the subject or context ; “ (i) “Government”? means the Government of Baluchistan; : ‘ (ii) “Lady Health Visitor” means a woman who has qualified the Lady Health Visitors Examination conducted by the West Pakistan Nursing Service Council, Lahore/Punjab Nursing Services Council, Lahore, Nursing Examination Board, Baluchistan, Quetta at the expense and quota of Government of Baluchistan.

equisition of | 3. . Notwithstanding anything contained in any other Law, a Lady Health Visitor shall be liable arvice. " to serve the Province of Baluchistan for a period of at least three years, if so required by the : Government— :

(a) if she has qualified as such on or after the first day of July, 1970, but before the commencement of this Act, within one year of the day of commencement of this Act;

(b) if she qualifies after the commencement of this Act, within one year of her qualifying.

Yffence and 4. Whoever disobeys the order of Government with respect to the requisitioning of her service or enalty. in any other manner defies the notice issued by the Government, shall suffer imprisonment for tvr9 " years and shall also be liable to fine which may extend to five thousand rupees.

5. No Court shall take cognizance of an offence under this Act, except on complaint by the Government or an officer authorised in this behalf by the Government and on the recommendation of the Committee constituted by the Government for the purpose. :
