WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Baluchistan Local Government Ordinance, 1980 (II of 1980);

AND WHEREAS the Governor is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

: NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 128 of the Constitution, read with Article 2 of the Provisional Constitution Order, 1981 (C.M.L.A. Order No. 1 of 1981), the Governor of Baluchistan is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance :-

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Baluchistan Local Government (Amendment) Ordinance, 1983,

(2) It shall come into force at once.

Baluchistan Local Government Ordinance, 1980,
to amend the said Ordinance, for Section 21 the
substituted :—

Disqualification of a candidate. A person shall be disqualified to be a candidate of a Local Council if he—

- (a) ceases to be a Citizen of Pakistan;
- (b) is an undischarged insolvent;

is of unsound mind and has been 90 days
(c) competent Court; or

(4) is a full-time salaried official of the Federal Government or of Provincial Government or of a public or statutory Corporation, a local council or other local authority;

(e) has been, on conviction for an offence involving moral turpitude, sentenced to imprisonment for a term of not

less than six months;

EXPLANATION: Moral turpitude means anything that injures the moral fibre of a person and lowers him down in moral values.

f) has been dismissed as a public servant within the

” Meaning Of Pakistan Penal Code (Act XLV of 1860);

(g) is retired servant of the Federal Government or a Provincial Government or of a public or statutory corporation, a

local council or other local body, unless two years have elapsed from the date of such retirement:

(b) is under contract for work to be done or goods to be supplied to the local authority concerned or has otherwise any pecuniary interest in its affairs:

i) is disqualified from the membership of any electing body under any law for the time being in force

(i) has been or is engaged directly or indirectly in subversive Or anti-State activities or propagating any opinion or acting in any manner prejudicial to the ideology of Pakistan

Or the sovereignty, integrity or security of Pakistan.

EXPLANATION: Anti-State activities shall include instigation to riots, labours or any other secession of people with a View to promote lawlessness or disorder."

said Ordinance, for Section 22 the following shall be

"Candidate not to contest election on party basis. A person

be disqualified to be a candidate or a member of a local council if he-

(8) gives himself out as candidate or a nominee of any existing or defunct political party;

(b) claims, draws or receives any financial or other assistance from any existing or defunct political party for the purpose of election; R

(c) bears, displays or carries any document, sign, insignia, flag or any other thing indicating affiliation to any existing or defunct political party;

(4) seeks the votes or sympathies of the people on party basis or manifesto of any existing or defunct political party; or

(c) seeks vote or support of the people by attributing direct or indirect Party affiliation to any of his opponents; and

(f) has at any time, on or after 20-12-1971, been an office bearer or a member of the executive committee of any existing or defunct political party, at Local, Divisional, Provincial or National level." -
