AND WHEREAS, the Provincial Assembly of Balochistan stands suspended in pursuance of the Proclamation of Emergency of the fourteenth day of October, 1999, and the Governor of Balochistan is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action:

NOW THEREFORE, in pursuance of Article =f the Provisional Constitution (Amendment) Order, 1999 (Chief Executive's Order No. 9 of 1999) and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the Governor of Balochistan is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance -

Short title and I (1) This Ordinance may be called the Balochistan Local Government Election (Second Amendment) Ordinance, 2001
(2) It shall come into force at once

Amendment of 2 After sub-section (3) of section 10. of the Balochistan section 10 of Local Government Election Ordinance, 2000, the following Ordinance VI of 2001. explanation shall be added, namely:

"Explanation.-- For the purpose of this section, all members of union councils notified as returned candidates in the elections held under this Ordinance shall be deemed to be members of the electoral college "
