Preamble, WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Baluchistan Medical Graduates (Compulsory Service) Act, 1974, for the purpose hereinafter appearing; ,

AND WHEREAS the Governor of Baluchistan is satisfied that the circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action; 2

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 128 of the Constitution, read with Article 2 of the Provisional Constitution Order, 1981 (Cy Order, No. 1 1981), the Governor of Baluchistan is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance — :

Short title and 1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Baluchistan Medical Graduates (Compulsory Service) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1984.

(2) It shall come into force at once and shall be deemed to have taken effect on the eighteenth day of December, 1974.

, Amendment of 2. ' In the Baluchistan Medical Graduates (Compulsory Service)

Section 3 of Act, 1974, in clause (b) of section 3; for the words «within one year of Act XX of 1974. his» the words «at any time after his» shall be substituted.
