An Act to requisition the services of Medical Graduates.

Preamble. WHEREAS it is expedient to secure the services of the
Medical Graduates for the Province of Balochistan;

It is hereby enacted as follows: —

Short title, extent 1. (1) This Act may be called the Balochistan Medical
and Graduates (Compulsory Service) Act, 1974.

t. (2) It shall come into force at once.

(3) It shall apply to the Province of Balochistan
except the Tribal Areas.

Definitions. 2. In this Act, unless there is anything repugnant in the
subject or context: —

(i) "Government" means the Government of
Balochistan;

(ii) "Medical Graduates" means a person who has
graduated in the faculty of medicine and surgery
or has undertaken any post-graduate or higher
degree in medicine or surgery at the expense of
the Government of Balochistan or has studied in
any other college or Institution against the
reserved seats of the former Quetta and Kalat
Divisions (now Balochistan) or was nominated
or may be nominated by the Government for
studies abroad.

Requisitioning of 3. Notwithstanding anything contained in any other law, a
Service. Medical Graduate shall be liable to serve the Province of
Balochistan for a period of at least five years, if so required by

Government: —

Making Rules.

(a) if he has graduated on or after the first day of July, 1970, but before the commencement of this Act within one year of the date of commencement of this Act;

(b) if he graduates after the commencement of this Act, '[at any time after his] graduation.

4. Whoever disobeys the order of Government with respect to the requisitioning of his service or in any other manner defies the notice issued by the Government, shall suffer imprisonment for two years and shall also be liable to fine which may extend to ten thousand rupees.

5. No Court shall take cognizance of an offence under this Act, except on complaint by the Government or an officer authorised in this behalf by the Government and on the recommendation of the Committee constituted by Government for the purpose.

6. Without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing provisions the Government may make 'rules to carry out the provisions of this Act.
