AND WHEREAS the Provincial Assembly of Balochistan stand
suspended in pursuance of the Proclamation of Emergency of the fourteenth
day of October, 1999. and the Governor of Balochistan is satisfied that
circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action:

NOW THEREFORE, in pursuance of Article 4 of the Provisional
Constitution (Amendment) Order, 1999 (Chief Executive's Order No. 9 of
1999), and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf the
Governor of Balochistan is pleased to make and promulgate the following
Ordinance:-

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Balochistan Motor Vehicles
(Amendment) Ordinance, 2001

(2) It shall come into force at once

Whereas in the Balochistan Motor Vehicles Ordinance, 1963 for section 32.
that

the following shall be substituted:-

"32,

sale of Motor Vehicles and Transfer of owner

(1) Sale of any motor vehicle. registered under this Chapter
and transfer of its ownership shall be in prescribed manner

(2) Contravention of this Section or the Rules made thereunder
shall be punishable by the Registering Authority with fine
which may not be less than 25% of the transfer fee for every
defaulting month.
