Preamble. WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Baluchistan Board of Technical Education Ordinance, 1962, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

. AND WHEREAS the Governor is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 128 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan and Article 2 of the Provisional Constitution Order, 1981 (CMLA Order No.1 of 1981), the Governor of Baluchistan is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

Short title and 1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Baluchistan Board of Technical Education (Amendment) Ordinance, 1984.

(2) It shall come into force at once.
