Preamble. WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Baluchistan Board of Technical Education Ordinance, 1962, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

. AND WHEREAS the Governor is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 128 of the Constitution of Baluchistan, the Governor of Baluchistan is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:- « -

Short title and commencement. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Baluchistan Board of Technical Education (Amendment) Ordinance, 1984.  
(2) It shall come into force at once.

Amendment in, 2. In the Baluchistan Board of Technical Education Ordinance, 1962 (XXXIX of 1962), in section 6, after

the word "final" at the end for the word "colon" XXXIX of shall be substituted and thereafter the following proviso shall be added, namely :-

“Provided that the member shall not be removed under the provisions of this section without first giving him an opportunity of showing cause and personal hearing against his removal.”
