THE BALOCHISTAN PROHIBITION OF EXPRESSING MATTERS ON WALLS  
ORDINANCE, 2001.

AN  
ORDINANCE

to prohibit the expression of matters on walls in the Province of  
Balochistan.

Preamble. WHEREAS. it is expedient to prohibit the expression of matters on  
the walls in the Province of Balochistan. in the manner hereinafter  
appearing:

AND WHEREAS, the Governor of Balochistan is satisfied that  
circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action:

NOW THEREFORE, in pursuance of Article 4 of the Provisional  
Constitution (Amendment) Order, 1999 (Chief Executive's Order No. 9 of  
1999), and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the  
Governor of Balochistan is pleased to make and promulgate the following  
Ordinance:-

Is (1) This Ordinance may be called the Balochistan Prohibition  
expressing matters on walls Ordinance, 2001

(2) It extends to the whole of Balochistan except Tribal Areas.

(3) It shall come into force at once.

2, Whoever affixes or causes to be affixed any poster, bill, notice,  
placard or other paper or means of advertisement on a wall or writes on  
any wall with chalk or paint or in any other manner whatsoever or  
expresses or describes any matters on any wall in any manner whatsoever  
with the intention to attract public attention to that matter shall be punished  
with imprisonment for a term which may extend to six months or with fine  
not exceeding Rs. 5,000/- or with both:

Provided that it shall not be an offence under this section, if the  
owner or possessor of the wall expresses any particulars relating to himself  
or his business thereon.

3s Within a period of 30 days from the commencement of this  
Ordinance every Local Council shall cause to be removed all matters  
expressed on the walls within its jurisdiction the expression of which is  
prohibited by this Ordinance.
