WHEREAS it is expedient further to  
amend the Baluchistan Provincial Council  
Ordinance, 1980 (VII of 1980) for the  
purpose hereinafter appearing :

AND WHEREAS the Governor is satis-  
fied that circumstances exist which, rend-«  
it necessary to. take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of  
the powers conferred. by Article 128 of  
the Constitution, read with Article 2 'cf  
the Provisional Constitution Order, 1981  
(C.M.L.A. Order No. 1. of 1981), the  
Governor of Baluchistan is pleased to  
make and. promulgate. the following  
Ordinance: -

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the  
Baluchistan Provincial Council (Amerd-  
ment) .Ordinance, 1984.

(2) It shall come into force at once.  
2. In the Baluchistan Provincial Council  
Ordinance, 1980 (VII of 1980), in Sec-  
tion 3, for sub-section (2), the following  
shall be substituted, namely:-

(2) The Council may consist of ;—

(i) All Mayors: of Municipal Corporations; —

(ii) All Chairmen, District Council /

(iii) All Chairmen, Municipal Committees; ;

(iv) One Chairman, Town Committee

from each Division to be elected  
by all the Chairmen to Town  
Committees in the Division;

(v) One representative of minorities  
to be elected by all the Local  
Councillors belonging to the  
minorities in the Province;

(vi) One representative of workers  
to be elected by all the Local  
Councillors representing the

. special interest group of work-  
, ers in the Province;

(vii) One woman representative from each Division to be elected by all the Local Councillors representing woman. in the Division;

(viii) One peasant representative from each Division to be elected by the Local Councillors representing the special interest group of peasants;

(ix) One representative of Trade and Industry to be elected by the Baluchistan Chamber of Commerce and Industry;

(x) One representative of Press to be elected by the members of Press representing newspapers and periodicals in Baluchistan.

(xi) One representative of private Medical Practitioners to be elected by the Pakistan Medical Association, Baluchistan Branch,

(xii) One representative of Advocates to be elected by the members of the Baluchistan Bar Council.

(xiii) One representative of Sports Organizations to be elected by different Sports Organizations, registered with the Government of Baluchistan.

(xiv) Any other person nominated by the Governor.
