WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Baluchistan Public Service Commission Ordinance, 1978 (Ordinance II of 1978), for the purpose hereinafter appearing;

AND WHEREAS the Governor is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action:

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of July 1977, read with the Laws (Continuance in Force) Order, 1977, (CMLA Order -No. 1 of 1977), and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf; the Governor of Baluchistan is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:- :

"1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Baluchistan

a Service Commission (Amendment) Ordinance, 1979, and shall come into force on the day 2nd of February 1979;

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2, In the Baluchistan Public Service Commission Ordinance, 1978 for the existing section 5 the following shall be substituted, namely :- an

'5. Ineligibility for further employment.

(2) Nothing contained in sub-section (1) shall

'6. to prevent a member other, than the Chairman, from being appointed as

(ii) to apply to a person who, at the time of the commencement of this Ordinance, was holding the office of the member and immediately before his appointment as member, was holding an office in the service of Pakistan”.
