"WHEREAS it is expedient to repeal and, with certain modifications,

re-enact the Baluchistan Public Service Commission Act, 1974 (Act IV of 1974).

AND WHEREAS the Governor of Baluchistan is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the proclamation of the fifth

day of July, 1977, read with the Laws (Continuance in Force) Order, 1977 (CMLA Order No. 1 of 1977), and in exercise of all powers enabling him ; in that behalf, the Governor of Baluchistan is pleased to make and a :
Enact the following Ordinance :—

@

Short title and Commencement :- (1) This Ordinance may be called :

"the Baluchistan public Service Commission Ordinance, 1978."

It shall come into force at once.

Definitions :- In this Ordinance, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or content,

(a) "Commission" means the Baluchistan Public Service Commission; and ,

- "(by "member" means a member of the Commission and includes the Chairman thereof,

Composition of Commission, etc. (1) There shall be a Baluchistan

'Public Service Commission;

and

(2) The Governor shall by regulations determine:-

(a) the number of members of the Commission and their conditions of service; and . ; '

and

(b) the number of members of the staff of the Commission and their conditions of service: '

Provided that the salary, allowances and privileges of a member of the Commission shall not be varied to his disadvantage during his term of office.

(3) The Chairman and other members of the Commission shall be appointed by the Governor.

(4) Not less than one half of the members of the Commission shall be persons who have held office in the service of Pakistan for not less than twenty years.

4. Term of office of members, etc. (1) The Governor may determine the term of office of the Chairman and other members which shall not exceed five years: a.

Provided that the Governor may extend the term of office of the Chairman or any other member for such period, not exceeding three

years, as he may deem fit; ~

~ = Provided further that a person holding office as Chairman or member immediately before the commencement of this Ordinance shall cease to hold office on such date as the Governor may direct.

5. A member may resign his office by writing under his hand and seal addressed to the Governor.

5. Ineligibility for further employment: (1) On ceasing to hold office, a member shall not be eligible for further employment in the service of
