An Ordinance to provide for the establishment of the
Balochistan University of Information Technology and
Management Sciences Quetta.

Preamble. WHEREAS it is expedient to provide for the
establishment of the Balochistan University of Information
Technology and Management Sciences Quetta and for matters
ancillary thereto;

AND WHEREAS the Governor of Balochistan is
satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to
take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of Article 4 of the
Provisional Constitution (Amendment) Order, 1999 (Chief
Executive's Order No. 9 of 1999) and in exercise of all powers
enabling him in that behalf, the Governor of Balochistan is
pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:—

Short title and 1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Balochistan
commencement. University of Information Technology ?[Engineering] and
Management Sciences Quetta Ordinance, 2002.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

Definitions. 2. In this Ordinance, unless there is anything repugnant in
the subject or context;

(a) "Academic Council" means the Academic
Council of the University;

"Authority" means any of the Authority of the University specified in this Ordinance;

"Chairperson" of a Department means Head of a Teaching Department;

"Chancellor". means the Chancellor of the University.

"Dean" means the Chairperson of the Board of a Faculty;

"Director" means the Director of an Institute;

"Faculty" means the Faculty of University.

"Government" means Government of Balochistan.

"Officer" means an Officer of the University specified in this Ordinance.

"Ordinance" means the Balochistan University of Information Technology, Engineering and Management Science Quetta, Ordinance, 2002 (Ordinance No XI of 2002);]

"Prescribed" means as prescribed by Regulation, rules or Statutes;

"Principal" means the head of a College.

"Professor Emeritus" and "Honorary Professor" means a retired Professor working in a Faculty in the capacity of an Emeritus or Honorary Professor.

"Pro-Vice Chancellor" means the Pro-Vice Chancellor of the University.]

"Regulation" "Rules" and "Statutes" mean respectively the Regulation, Rules and Statutes made or deemed to have been made under this Ordinance.

(o) "Syndicate" means the Syndicate of the University.

"I(o-a) "Senate" means the senate of the University, constituted under section 18-A of this Act;]

(p) "Teacher" includes Professor, Associate Professors, Assistant Professor, Lecturers and research staff engaged whole time by the University for teaching degree, honors or post graduate classes and such other persons as may be recognized to be Teachers by the University.

(q) "Teaching Department" means a constituent Institute, College or Department, where teaching or research is being undertaken;

(1) = "University College/Institute" means a College/Institute maintained and administered by the University;

(s) "University" means the Balochistan University of Information Technology'[, Engineering] and Management Sciences Quetta constituted under this Ordinance, and includes University Institute, Department and Colleges and

(t) "Vice-Chancellor" means the Vice-Chancellor of the University.

Establishment of the 3. (1) There shall be established a University to be University. called Balochistan University of Information Technology'[, Engineering] and Management Sciences Quetta consisting of the Chancellor, the Vice-Chancellor, the Dean, members of Syndicate, the Academic Council, the Board of Faculties the member of University bodies, the teachers and students of the University, its constituent units and Colleges and such other officers and members of staff as may, from time to time, be determined, to be the offices and members of staff of the University.

(2) The University shall be a body corporate by name of Balochistan University of Information Technology'[, Engineering] and Management Sciences Quetta having

University open to all.

The power and function of the University.

perpetual succession and a common seal, with power among others, to acquire, hold and dispose of any property or investment and shall by the said name sue and be sued.

4. The University shall be open to persons of either sex of whatever religion, race creed, color or domicile who are academically qualified for admission to the course of study offered by University and no such person shall be denied the privileges of the University on the ground of sex, religion, creed, caste, race class, colour or domicile.

5. (1) The purpose of the University shall be the promotion and dissemination of knowledge in areas of emerging science and Technology to provide for instruction, training research, demonstration and service in such branches of learning as the University may determine.

(2) The University shall have the powers:—

(a) to provide for instruction in such branches of learning as it may deem fit, and to make provisions for research and for the advancement and dissemination of knowledge in such manner as it may determine;

(b) to admit and examine students;

(c) to award and confer degrees, diplomas, certificates and other academic distinctions to and on persons who have been admitted to and have passed its examinations under prescribed conditions;

(d) to confer degrees on persons who have carried out independent research under prescribed conditions;

(e) to confer in the manner prescribed honorary degrees or other distinctions on persons approved by the syndicate for the purpose;

(f) to affiliate other institution or branches or
Departments thereof, to recognize
selected members of the staff thereof as
teachers or the University, to admit the

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members thereof to any of the privileges of the University and to accept attendance at courses of study at the University upon such terms and conditions and subject to such Regulation as may from time to time be determined by the University and established campuses, Faculties in Pakistan or abroad under prescribed conditions and in accordance with any law for the time being in forced in this behalf for better discharge of its functions and responsibilities;

to admit Colleges and other educational institutions to its privileges withdraw such privileges under prescribed manner;

to inspect Colleges, affiliated or seeking affiliation with it;

to accept the examinations passed, on the periods of study spent by the students, of the University at other Universities, Colleges or places of learning as equivalent to such examinations and periods of study in the University as it may determine, and to withdraw such acceptances;

to Institute Professorship, Associate Professorship, Assistant Professorship, or Lectureships and any other posts and to appoint person thereto and to remove them from such offices, and to prescribe the conditions of service;

to create posts in connection with teaching, research extension, training and

administration of affairs and for any other purpose related thereto and appoint persons thereto;

to Institute and award fellowships, scholarships, bursaries, medals, prizes and other aids of study and research under prescribed manner;

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to establish Institutes, Colleges, Departments, Centers of advanced studies Museums, Herbaria and other centers of learning for the development of teaching and research and to make suitable arrangements for the maintenance, management and administration;

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to charge and receive such fees and other payments as it may determine;

to use the financial and other resources allocated to it for the execution of functions;

to make provisions for research and advisory services and with these objectives to enter into

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arrangements with other institutions or with public bodies within Pakistan and abroad under prescribed conditions and in accordance with any law for the time being in force in this behalf;

to enter into agreements, contracts and other arrangements with institutional bodies and individuals for carrying out its

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functions and activities;

to receive and manage property transferred, or grants, bequests, trust gifts, donations, endowments and other contributions made, to the University and invest any Fund representing such property, grants, bequests, trusts, gift, donations,

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endowments or contributions and convert
one kind of property into another, in
such manner as it may deem fit;

to provide for reward or otherwise, such
good and services for members of staff of
the University and their families guests
and servants as may be deemed expedient
and consistent with the object of the

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University as a place of education
learning and research .

to deprive persons of any degrees,
diplomas, licenses, certificates or other
distinctions conferred on or granted to
them by the University for reasons to be
given by the University;

to prescribe rules for the Discipline of the

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students of the University;

to make provision for research, design, development and advisory services and with these objects to enter into such arrangements with other institutions, companies, organizations or bodies as may be thought desirable, and

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to establish and maintain and _ to
administer and govern hostels and other
institutions for 'the residence of the
students of the University and to
supervise such hostels and _ other
institutions and license and supervise
other places of residence, whether or not
maintained by the University.

Teaching and
examinations.

6. (1) All recognized teaching in various courses in the University and affiliated Colleges shall be conducted in the prescribed manner, and it may include lectures, discussions, seminar, demonstrations as well as practical work in laboratories and workshops and other methods of instruction including, but not limited to voice, graphics, text, dynamic content, and data structures of all types whether they are in electronic, visual, auditory, optical or any other form.

(2) The teaching in any prescribed course in the University, constituent Colleges or Affiliated Colleges shall be organized by such Authority as may be prescribed.

(3) The courses and the curricula for teaching in the University and Affiliated Colleges shall be such as may be prescribed.

(4) A Discipline to be called "Islamic and Pakistan studies" shall be offered, as a compulsory subject at Bachelor's

Jurisdiction of the
University.

level in the University and Affiliated Colleges; provided that
non-Muslim students may opt for "Ethics and Pakistan studies".

(5) The University may associate external examiners
for conduct of examinations as and when necessary.

7. The University shall exercise the powers conferred on it
by or under this Ordinance within the territorial limits of the
Balochistan Province and in respect of the institution over

which it has jurisdiction in accordance with law.

15. The Accounts officer

16. Such other officers as may be appointed by the Syndicate.

Chancellor. 9. (1) The Governor of Balochistan shall be the Chancellor of the University.

(2) the Chancellor or in his absence, the Vice Chancellor shall preside at the convocation of the University.

(3) Where the Chancellor is satisfied that the proceedings of any Authority or the orders of any Officers are not in accordance with the provision of this Ordinance, Statutes, the Regulations or the Rules, he may, after calling upon such Authority or Officer to show cause as to why such proceedings or orders should not be annulled, and by an order in writing, annul such proceedings or orders.

(4) Every proposal to confer an honorary degree

shall subject to confirmation by the Chancellor.

(5) The Chancellor shall have the powers to assent to such Statutes as are required to be submitted to him by the University or withhold assent or refer them back to the University for reconsideration.

(6) The Chancellor may remove any person from the memberships of any Authority of the University if such

person:—

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- (b)

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has become of unsound mind; or

has become subject to an incapacity from
functioning as a member of such
Authority; or

does not attend three consecutive
meetings without intimation to the

Vice Chancellor; or

(d) remains absent from the country for more-then six months without intimation to the Vice Chancellor; or

(e) has been convicted by the court of law of an offence involving moral turpitude.

Visitation. 10. (1) The Chancellor may cause an inspection or

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inquiry to be made in respect of any matter directly or indirectly

connected with affairs of the University and shall from time to time appoint one or more persons to conduct inspection of:—

(a) the University its buildings, libraries,

museums, workshops and or any other

installation.

(b) any institution College or hostel maintained, recognized or licensed by the

University.

(c) the teaching and other work conducted
held by the University.

(d) the conduct of examination held by the

University.

(2) The Chancellor shall give notice to the syndicate
of his intention to cause an inspection or inquiry to be made

under sub-section (1) and the Syndicate shall be entitled to be represented there at.

(3) After the inspection or inquiry is completed the Chancellor shall cause his views as a result thereof to be communicated to the Syndicate and after ascertaining the reaction of the Syndicate, the Chancellor may advise the Syndicate to refrain from taking an action or to take such action within such time, as he may specify in this behalf.

Vice-Chancellor.

(4) Where the Syndicate fails to carry out the advice of the Chancellor given under sub-section (3), the Chancellor may, after considering the explanation or representations, if any made by the Syndicate, issue such directions as he may deem fit, and the Vice Chancellor shall comply with such directions.

11. (1) The Vice Chancellor shall be appointed by the Chancellor on such terms and conditions as the Chancellor may determine, and shall hold office during the pleasure of the

Powers and duties of
the Vice-

Chancellor for a term not exceeding four years.

(2) At any time when the office of Vice Chancellor is vacant or he is absent or is unable to perform the functions of the office due to illness or some other cause, the Chancellor shall make such arrangements for the performance of the duties of the Vice Chancellor as he may deem fit.

12. (1) The Vice-Chancellor shall be the principal

Chancellor.

executive and academic officer of the University and shall ensure that the provisions or this Ordinance, the Statutes, the Regulation and the Rules are faithfully observed in order to promote general efficiency and good order the University and shall have all powers necessary for this purpose include administrative control over all officers teachers and students employees of University.

(2) The Vice Chancellor shall, besides presiding at

convocation of University in the absence of the Chancellor, shall if present preside at the meetings of the Authorities or other bodies of the University, Colleges and institutions of which Vice-Chancellor may not be the head.

(3) The Vice Chancellor may take such action in an emergency as may be considered necessary by him and report thereafter as soon as possible, the action so taken to the officers, Authority or other body which in the ordinary course, would

have taken that action.

(4) The Vice Chancellor shall also have the powers:—

(a) to create and fill temporary posts for a period not exceeding six months;

(b) to sanction all expenditure provided for in the approved budget and appropriate

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Funds within the same major head expenditure;

to sanctions re-appropriation of an amount not exceeding five hundred thousand rupees for an unforeseen item not provided for in the budget, report into the Syndicate at the next meeting;

to appoint paper setters and examiners for

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all examinations of University after receiving panels of names from the relevant Authority;

to make such arrangements for the scrutiny of papers, marks and results he may consider necessary;

to direct teachers, officers and employees of the University to take assignments

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in connection with teaching, research, examination, administration and such other activities of University as he may consider necessary for the purposes of the University;

to delegate subject to such conditions, if any, as may be prescribed, any of the powers under Ordinance to an Officer or

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the employees of the University;

to exercise general control and supervision over the system of examination in the University;

to exercise and perform such other powers and functions as may be prescribed;

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to appoint visiting Professor, Associate Professors, Assistant Professors and Lecturers in various Disciplines for a periods not more than one Academic year on the terms and conditions as may be prescribed and

to appoint employees below the rank of Lecturer and equivalent office.

There shall be a Pro-Vice Chancellor of the

Chancellor.

University, who shall be appointed by the Chancellor for a term of three years, with first year on probation, extendable to another term, and on such terms and conditions as the Chancellor may determine.

(2) The Chancellor, either on the recommendation of the Senate or in pursuant to a resolution passed by a majority of three fourth of its members or himself on his discretion, may by an executive order remove the Pro-Vice Chancellor on the ground of inefficiency, moral turpitude, physical or mental incapacity or gross misconduct including misuse of position for personal advantage of any kind.]

12-B. (1) The Pro-Vice Chancellor shall assist the Vice Chancellor in all the matters and affairs of the University.

(2) All matters requiring orders, approval and sanctions of the Vice Chancellor, shall be routed through the Pro-Vice Chancellor.

(3) The Pro-Vice Chancellor shall be an Ex- officio member of all the Statutory Bodies of the University, such as, the Senate, the Syndicate, the Academic Council, the Finance

and Planning Committee, the Advanced Studies and Research Board, the Selection Board/Committee etc.]

Registrar. 13. The Registrar will be a whole time officer of the University and shall be appointed by the [Senate on the recommendation of the Syndicate] on such terms and conditions as may be determined by it, he shall;

(a) be the custodian of the common seal and the

No. 87 & 88 of 2007; later through another decision passed on 31st July, 2009 by the Honorable Supreme Court in C.P. No. 87 & 88 of 2009, it was decided that the same require approval of the Provincial Assembly within the period as prescribed in Article 124 of the Constitution of Pakistan, 1973, from the date of judgment. A bill for the amendments was tabled in the Provincial Assembly of Balochistan which remained pending and was lapsed on the dissolution of the Assembly.

of the Finance and Planning Committee.

15. The Controller of Examination shall be a whole time
Officer of the University and shall be appointed by the '[Senate
on the recommendation of the Syndicate] on such terms and
conditions as may be determined by it. He shall be responsible
for all matters pertaining to the conduct of examinations and
perform such other duties as may be prescribed.

Auditor. 16. (1) The annual audit of the University shall be conducted by the Audit Department of Government.

(2) There shall be an internal auditor of the University to be appointed by the [Syndicate]⁺ on such terms and conditions as may be determined by it.

(3) The internal auditor shall be responsible for pre auditing of all bills and documents for all payment to be made

Other officers. 17. Subject to the provisions of this Ordinance, the terms and conditions of service and the powers and duties of other officers of the University shall be such as may be prescribed.

Provided that the special focus or affiliation of the University, to be

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declared in the manner prescribed, may be reflected in the number of persons of distinction in an area of expertise relevant to the University who are appointed to the Senate;

one person from amongst the alumni of the University;

two persons, one male and one female

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from the academic community of the country, other than an employee of the University, at the level of professor or principal of a college;

Two out of four University teachers; one male and one female to be nominated by the Academic Council, and

one person nominated by the Higher

Education Commission of Pakistan.

(2) The numbers of the members described in clauses (e) to (h) of sub-section (1), may be increased by the Senate through statutes:

Provided that the total membership of the Senate shall not exceed twenty-one with a maximum of five University Teachers; and this increase shall be balanced to the extent possible, across the different categories of the members

specified in sub-section (1).

(3) All the members of the Senate shall be appointed by the Chancellor:

Provided that the appointments of persons described in clauses (e) to (f) of sub-section (1) shall be made from amongst a panel of three names for each vacancy, recommended by the Representation Committee set up in terms of section 23 and the procedure as may be prescribed:

Provided further that effort shall be made, without compromising on quality of qualification, to give fair representation to women on the Senate:

Provided further that as regard the University teachers described in clause (g) of sub-section (1), the Senate shall prescribe a procedure for appointment to be based on the seniority and academic accomplishment and _national/international recognition or the Senate may in alternate decide that appointments of the University teachers as members to the

Senate shall also be in the same manner as provided for the persons described in clauses (e) to (f) of sub-section (1).

(4) The members of Senate other than the ex-officio members shall hold office for three years, who on expiration of the three years from the date of their appointment by the Chancellor, shall cease to be a member of the Senate unless appointed for an other term. (1) Any officer, Teacher or Employee of the University, on the recommendations of the '[Senate], may be directed to serve in any position in the University, under Government or educational research institution in the public interest, provided that the terms and conditions offered to him shall not be less favourable than those admissible to him in the University and full benefit of his previous service shall be allowed to him.

(2) Government may, in consultation with the *[Senate], place the services of an employee of Government or any other University or an educational or research institution at the disposal of the University in the public interest, provided that the terms and conditions offered to him or her shall not be less favourable than those enjoyed by him/her immediately before his/her services are placed at the disposal of the University and that full benefit of his/her services are placed at the disposal of the University, and that full benefit of his/her previous service shall be allowed to him/her.

to Balochistan University of Information Technology and Engineering and Management Sciences, the Senate shall be constituted and the members thereof shall be appointed by the Chancellor in accordance with the numbers and criteria for membership specified in the Ordinance as amended by this Act, The University Teachers shall be appointed to the Senate by the Chancellor, The number of University Teachers to be appointed to the first Senate shall be as provided in the Ordinance as amended by this Act. 4. (1) There shall be a separate Board of Studies for each subject or group of subjects, as may be prescribed by Regulations.

(2) Each Board of Studies shall consist of:—

(i) the Chairperson/Director of the registered Institute.

(ii) All Professors and Associate Professors in the University Teaching Department/ Institute.

(iii) | Two experts to be appointed by the Vice-Chancellor.

(iv) Three teachers, other than University teachers, to be appointed by the Vice-Chancellor from affiliated colleges, and

(v) One Assistant Professor and one Lecturer to be appointed by rotation in order of seniority from the Department concerned, provided that in the case of professional subjects which are taught in the affiliated Institute/ colleges only and not in the University, such as Medicine, Dentistry, and Education, etc. the Board of Studies shall consist of :—

(a) the principals of the Colleges, Directors for the Institute, heads of the Institute concerned.
