Amendment of  
section 4 of  
Act V of 1958.

AND WHEREAS the Provincial Assembly of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa stands suspended in pursuance of Proclamation of Emergency, of the fourteenth day of October, 1999, and the Governor of Balochistan is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action:

Now THEREFORE, in pursuance of Article 4 of the Provisional Constitution (Amendment) Order, 1999 (Chief Executive's Order, No. 9 of 1999), and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the Governor of Balochistan is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:~

(1) This Ordinance may be called the Balochistan Urban Immovable Property Tax (Amendment) Ordinance, 2001.  
(2) It shall come into force at once

2. In the Balochistan Urban Immovable Property Tax Act, 1958, for clause(h) of section 4, the following shall be substituted:-

"(h) One residential house owned and self occupied for his residential purpose by every citizen".
