REGULATION, 1968

(W. P. Regulation I of 1968)

[11 January, 1968]

A Regulation to apply the Co-operative Societies Act,
1925, to the Tribal Areas of Quetta Division.

WHEREAS it is expedient to apply the provisions of
the Co-operative Societies Act, 1925 (Sind Act VII of 1925), to
the Tribal Areas of Quetta Division;

AND WHEREAS clause (2) of Article 223 of the
Constitution provides that the Governor of a Province, with the
approval of the President, may, with respect to any matter
within the legislative competence of the Provincial Legislature,
make regulations for a Tribal Area or any part of a Tribal Area
situated in the Province;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers
conferred on him by clause (2) of Article 223 of the
Constitution, and having received the approval of the President,
the Governor of West Pakistan is pleased to make and
promulgate the following Regulation:—

1. qd) This Regulation may be called the Co- operative
Societies Act, 1925 (Application to Tribal Areas of Quetta
Division) Regulation, 1968.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. The Co-operative Societies Act, 1925 (Sind Act VII of
1925), and so far as may be, all rules, regulations, notifications
and orders, made or issued thereunder and in force immediately
before the commencement of this Regulation, shall apply to the
Tribal Areas of Quetta Division.
