ACT, 1969

An Act to amend the Conciliation Courts Ordinance,  
1961.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Conciliation  
Courts Ordinance, 1961;

It is hereby enacted as follows:—

1. qd) This Act may be called the Conciliation Courts  
(West Pakistan Amendment) Act, 1969;

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Conciliation Courts Ordinance, 1961, hereinafter  
referred to as the said Ordinance, in section 8, after sub-section  
(2), the following new sub-section shall be added, namely:—

"(2-a) In the commutation of the period of thirty  
days provided under sub-section (2) for making an  
application, the provisions of sections 5 and 12 of the  
Limitation Act, 1908 (Act IX of 1908) shall apply."

3. In sub-section (2) of section 16 of the said Ordinance:—  
(a) between the word "court" and the word "is", the  
words and comma "is unable to appear

personally due to any disability, or" be inserted;

and

(b) for the word "her" the words "such person" be substituted.
