ORDINANCE, 1980

(Balochistan Ordinance XXI of 1980)

[9" December, 1980]

An Ordinance to amend the Court Fees Act, 1870 (VII  
of 1870), in its application to the Province of Balochistan.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Court Fees  
Act, 1870, for the purpose hereinafter appearing;

AND WHEREAS the Governor is satisfied that  
circumstances exist which render it necessary to take  
immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamation  
of the fifth day of July, 1977°, read with the Laws (Continuance  
in Force) Order, 1977, (CMLA Order No. 1 of 1977)4, and in  
exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the Governor  
of Balochistan is pleased to make and promulgate the following  
Ordinance: —

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Court Fees  
(Balochistan Amendment) Ordinance, 1980.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. Section 35-A of the Court Fees Act, 1870, shall be  
omitted.

3. Subject to the remission granted by Notification of Law  
Department of Balochistan Government dated 27" July, 1978 as  
amended by Notification dated 26" December, 1979, in  
Schedule I of the Court Fees Act, 1870°, for the entries in

columns No. 2 and 3 against Article No. 1, the following shall be substituted, namely: —
