WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Court Fees Act, 1870, in its application to the Province of Baluchistan for the purpose hereinafter appearing;

AND WHEREAS the Governor is Satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 128 of the Constitution, read with Article 2 of the Provisional Constitution Order, 1981 (C.M.L.A. Order No. 1 of 1981), the Governor of Baluchistan is pleased to: make and promulgate the following Ordinance: -

is (1). This Ordinance may be called the Court Fees (Baluchistan Amendment) Ordinance. 1984.

- (2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Court Fees Act, 1870, in its application to the Province of Baluchistan, hereinafter referred to as the said Act, / Sections 19—A, 19—B, 19—C, 19—D, 19—E, 19—F, 19—G, 19—H, 19—I, 19—J, shall be omitted.
