ORDINANCE, 1980

(Balochistan Ordinance XIV of 1980)

[22 October, 1980]

An Ordinance further to amend the Criminal Law
(Special Provisions) Ordinance, 1968 (Ordinance II of 1968) in
its application to the Province of Balochistan.

WHEREAS, it is expedient further to amend the
Criminal Law (Special Provisions) Ordinance, 1968, in the
manner hereinafter appearing;

AND WHEREAS, the Governor is satisfied that
circumstances exist which render it necessary to take
immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamation
of the fifth day of July, 1977°, read with the Laws (Continuance
in Force) Order, 1977 (CMLA Order No. 1 of 1977)*, and in
exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the Governor
of Balochistan is pleased to make and promulgate the following
Ordinance: —

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Criminal Law
(Special Provisions) (Balochistan Amendment) Ordinance,
1980.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Criminal Law (Special Provisions) Ordinance,
1968, for the fullstop at the end of the proviso to sub-section (1)
of section 4, a semicolon shall be substituted and thereafter the
following further provisos shall be added, namely: —

"Provided further that the Deputy Commissioner or political Agent may direct an inquiry or investigation to be made by such other person as he thinks fit for the purpose of

ascertaining truth or falsehood of a complaint and such other person shall for the purpose of the said inquiry or investigation exercise all the powers conferred by the Code of Criminal Procedure 1898° on an Officer Incharge of the Police Station:

Provided also that if the result of inquiry/ investigation indicates that no offence has been committed the Deputy Commissioner or Political Agent, may instead of making reference to Tribunal dismiss the Complaint."
