ORDINANCE, 1970

(West Pakistan Ordinance VIII of 1970)

[6" February, 1970]

An Ordinance to amend the Explosive Substances Act,
1908, in its application to the Province of West Pakistan.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Explosive
Substances Act, 1908, in its application to the Province of West
Pakistan in the manner hereinafter appearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Martial Law
Proclamation of 25" March, 1969, read with the Provisional
Constitution Order, and in pursuance of all powers enabling
him in that behalf, the Governor of West Pakistan is pleased to
make and promulgate the following Ordinance: —

1. () This Ordinance may be called the Explosive
Substances (West Pakistan Amendment) Ordinance, 1970.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Explosive Substances Act, 1908, in its application
to the Province of West Pakistan, in section 7, between the
word "Government" and the full-stop at the end, the words "or
an officer authorised in this behalf by the Provincial
Government" shall be inserted.

This Ordinance was promulgated by the Governor of West Pakistan on 30" January, 1970; published in the West Pakistan Ga

(Extraordinary), dated 6"" February, 1970, pages 271-272; saved by Article 281 of the Interim Constitution of Pakistan (1972);
validated by Act LXIII of 1975.
