WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Land
Reforms (Baluchistan Pat Feeder Canal) Regulation 1972, for the
Purposes hereinafter appearing;

AND WHEREAS the circumstances
exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

and, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamation of
Emergency of 1973 read with the Laws (Continuance in Force)
1977 (CM Order No. 1 of 1977), and in exercise of
power conferred on him in that behalf, the Governor of Baluchistan is
pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:—

Ordinance may be called the Land Reforms (Baluchistan
Pat Feeder Canal) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1978:

(2) It shall apply to the whole of Baluchistan.

It shall come into force from the date of its promulgation
to have taken effect on the fifteenth day of March, 1978,

2 In the Land Reforms (Baluchistan Pat Feeder Canal)

Regulation, 1972, hereinafter referred to as the said Regulation,

paragraph 3 shall be renumbered as sub-paragraph (1) of that paragraph

and, after sub-paragraph (1) as aforesaid, the following shall be
added, namely:

(2) In the exercise of their functions under this
Regulation, the Board of Revenue and other authorities

shall be subject to the supervision and control of the
Provincial Government and shall comply with any special
directions issued by it."

3. In the said Regulation, in paragraph 16, for the words "Federal Government" twice occurring, the words "Provincial Government" shall be substituted.

4. In the said Regulation, for paragraph 17, the following shall be substituted, namely :-

* 17. Powers of Provincial Government .. The Provincial Government or any person authorised by it in that behalf may at any time, of its or his own motion or otherwise, call for the record of any case or proceeding under this Regulation which is pending or in which the Board of Revenue or any other authority has passed an order and may pass such order in relation thereto as the Government may deem fit, or, as the case may be, such person, &

Provided that the Provincial Government may, from time to time, specify the cases or class of cases in which it desires to pass final orders:

Provided further that no color deal Se. pretend eater this sub-parspraph revising or modifving an order affecting and person wailess such person has been afforded an opportunity of being heard!

Provided further that the record of any case or proceeding fn which the Board of Revenue or other authority has passed af order shall not be calied for under this parapreph by the Pryvineial Government or the person authorised by it—

(a) of its or his own motion, after the 3Jst day of March, 1979, or

a)

(b) on the application of any aggrieved prson made after the expiration of sixty days from the date of such order or from the enactment of the Land Reforms (Amendment) Act, 1973 (LXI] of 1973), whichever is later, exclud ng the tine requisite for obtaining a copy of such order.'
