WHERPAS it is expedient further to amend the Land Reforms (Baluchistan Pat Feeder Canal) Regulation 1972, for the Purposes hereinafter appearing;

AND WHEREAS it is necessary that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

wherefore, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamation of the State of Salt BY . read with the Laws (Continuance in Force) 1977 (CM Order No. I of 1977), and in exercise of powers given to him in that behalf, the Governor of Baluchistan is hereby made and promulgate the following Ordinance:—

Ordinance may be called the Land (Baluchistan Pat Feeder Canal) (Anendment) Ordinance, 198:

(2) It shall apply to the whole of Baluchistan.

3. In the said Regulation, in paragraph 16, for the words "Federal Government" twice occurring, the words "Provincial Government" shall be substituted.

4. In the said Regulation, for paragraph 17, the following shall be substituted, namely :-

* 17. Powers of Provincial Government .. The Provincial Government or any person authorized by it in that behalf may at any time, of its or his own motion or otherwise, call for the record of any case or proceeding under this Regulation which is pending or in which the Board of Revenue or any other authority has passed an order and may pass such order in relation thereto as the Secretary or, as the case may be, such person thinks fit.

Provided that the Provincial Government may, from time to time, specify the cases or class of cases in which it desires to pass final orders:
