'THE PRISONERS (BALUCHISTAN AMENDMENT)
ORDINANCE, 1985

(Baluchistan Ordinance VII of 1985)

[6th January, 1985]

An Ordinance further to amend the Prisoner Act, 1900 (III of 1900), in its application to the Province of Baluchistan.

Preamble. WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Prisoners Act, 1900, in its application to the Province of Baluchistan in the manner hereinafter appearing;

AND WHEREAS the Governor is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 128 of the Constitution, read with Article 2 of the Provisional Constitution Order, 1981 (C.M.L.A. Order No. 1 of 1981), the Governor of Baluchistan is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance: —

Short title and 1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Prisoners Commencement (Baluchistan Amendment) Ordinance, 1985.

(2) It shall come into force at once and shall be deemed to have taken effect on the 1st day of October, 1984.

Amendment of 2. In the Prisoners Act, 1900, in its application to the section 40 of Province of Baluchistan, in section 40, the commas and the words Act III of 1900. “and, if it thinks fit,” shall be deleted.
