ORDINANCE, 2002

(Balochistan Ordinance No. VIII of 2002)

[8 April, 2002]

An Ordinance further to amend the Stamp Act, 1899? (II
of 1899).

WHEREAS, it is expedient further to amend the Stamp
Act, 1899, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

AND WHEREAS, the Governor of Balochistan is
satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to
take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of Article 4 of the
Provisional Constitution (Amendment) Order, 1999 (Chief
Executive's Order No. 9 of 1999), and in exercise of all powers
enabling him in that behalf, the Governor of Balochistan is
pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:—

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Stamp
(Balochistan 2nd Amendment) Ordinance, 2002.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Stamp Act, 1899, in sub clause (b) of clause (9)

of Section 2, for the words "Deputy Commissioner" the words
"Executive District Officer (Revenue) shall be substituted.
