A Regulation to provide for the extension of the West
Pakistan Civil Courts Ordinance, 1962', to the Tribal Areas of
Quetta Division.

WHEREAS clause (2) of Article 223 of the Constitution
of the Republic of Pakistan provides that the Governor of West
Pakistan with the approval of the President may, with respect to
any matter within the legislative competence of the Provincial
Legislature, make regulations for a Tribal Area or any part of a
Tribal Area situated in the Province;

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to provide for the
extension of the West Pakistan Civil Courts Ordinance, 1962, to
the *Tribal Areas of Quetta Division;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Governor of West Pakistan,
with the approval of the President, is pleased to make the
following Regulations:—

1. qd) This Regulation may be called the West Pakistan
Civil Courts Ordinance (Extension to *Tribal Areas of Quetta
Division) Regulation, 1963.

(2) It extends to the ?Tribal Areas forming part of
Quetta Division.

2. The West Pakistan Civil Courts Ordinance, 1962, as in
force from time to time, shall apply to the *Tribal Areas of
Quetta Division.

An Ordinance promulgated by the Governor of West Pakistan on 10 November, 1961; published in the W.P. Gazette (Extraor

dated 8th January, 1962, pages 87-96; saved and given permanent effect by Article 225 of the Constitution of Pakistan (1962); the Constitution of Pakistan (1973), adopted by the Baln. Laws (Adaptation) Order 1975, with substitution of the word "Balochi" for the words "West Pakistan".

2 For Provincial Administration Tribal Areas of Balochistan see Article 246 (b) (ii) of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan (1973), which were a part of Quetta Division in the year 1963.
