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2 Definitions —(i) In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires, - on
the following expressions shall have the meanings hereby assigned to them that is _

: (a) 'Order' means the Govt. of Gilgit-Baltistan Order-2018.

(b) 'Chief Minister' means Chief Minister of Gilgit Baltistan.

(c) _ 'Family' means (the parents, the wife, legitimate and step children

(d) 'Government' means the Government of Gilgit-Baltistan.
