To provide for the Salaries, Allowances and Privileges of the
Ministers Gilgit Baltistan.

Whereas it is expedient to provide for the Salaries, Allowances and
Privileges of the Ministers of Gilgit Baltistan for the purpose herein-after
appearing; ; ;

It is hereby enacted as follows:

1. Short title and commencement.—(i) This Act shall be called the
Ministers Gilgit-Baltistan (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) Act No. IV of
2021 : '

Rs.8,000/- per day as Daily Allowance during attending of Government finctions/ meetings in the discharge of official duties undertaken outside his jurisdiction subject to production of invitation issued by the.competent authority.
