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Act

to provide a law for social protection of vulnerable  
population of Azad Jammu and Kashmir

Whereas, it is expedient to provide a law for social  
protection of vulnerable population of Azad Jammu and

Kashmir for securing. their life necessities through

subsistence allowance and matters connected therewith and

ancillary thereto;

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It is hereby enacted as follows:-

Short title and commencement.- (1) This Act may be called the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Social Protection

of Vulnerable Population Act, 2024.

(2) It shall extend to the whole of Azad Jammu and Kashmir.

(3) It shall come into force at once and shall be deemed to have taken effect since 10 March, 2024.

Definitions.- In this Act, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context,-

(a) "Board" means, the Board constituted under Section 3 of this Act;

(b) "Contributors" means and includes,-

i) President, Azad Jammu and Kashmir; and

ii) Prime Minister, Ministers, Judges of the Supreme Court and High Court, Members Legislative Assembly, Elected Members AJ&K Council, Chairman & Members of all Tribunals and their employees, all Civil Servants, all employees of statutory bodies, autonomous bodies, special institutions and any other person getting salaries from

Government exchequer in BPS-7 and

above.

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“Nifferently Abled Person” means, a person who is unable to earn his living wage due to some physical and mental deformity, and is

declared as such by the medical board, specially

constituted for the purposes of this Act by the. \_\_\_\_

Government;

“Government” means, the Azad Government of the State of Jammu and Kashmir;

“Member” means, a member of the Board and includes Chairman;

Minimum Standard of Living” means, such standards which may be prescribed by the Board;

“Fund” means, the Social Protection Trust Fund, established under Section 5 of this Act.

“Subsistence Allowance” means, an allowance. to be paid to a Vulnerable Person, on monthly basis and on such rate, as may be prescribed by the Board;

“Vulnerable Person” means, a widow, orphan, differently abled person, transgender and divorced women duly registered with the Religious Affairs Department, who lacks necessities of life, and having no \_ other

satisfactory means of subsistence;

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Explanation: For the purpose

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of this clause,-

a child who has lost

“Orphan” means,

persons of

his/her father and is less than 21 years of age

and he/she or any other family member

does not have sufficient means of

income to sustain minimum standard of

family

living;

“Transgender” means, a person who is declared as such by a medical board to be constituted by the Government, and who does not have minimum means of income

to maintain a normal standard of living;

“Widow/Divorced Women” means, a woman who is alone and she or anyone of her dependents do not have sufficient means of income to sustain minimum

standard of life; and

“Old Person” means, a person qualifies for social assistance as an elderly person,

if the person,-

(a) has attained age of 65; and

(b) has been neglected or abandoned without any ascertainable means of

support or lives or begs on the street

for a living.



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Board.- (1) There shall be a Board to be called Social Protection Board consisting of the following members

by virtue of their offices, namely:-

Minister Finance

Minister Social Welfare

(2) The Board shall be a body corporate having

perpetual succession and a common seal and shall by  
the said name sue and be sued.

(3) The meeting of the Board shall be held at least  
once in each quarter, the chairman may, however,  
convene a special meeting at any time.

(4) At least three days' notice alongwith agenda of

the meeting shall be given before convening a meeting.

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(5) Members of the Board shall not be entitled for

any remuneration or TA/DA for performance of functions under this Act and shall work purely on honorary basis.

(6) All decisions of the meeting shall be recorded

and maintained by Secretary of the Board, who shall also be responsible for;-

(i) the conduct of correspondence on behalf of the Board;

(ii) the maintenance of all records of the Board;

(iii) the presentation of annual budget for each financial year to the Board;

(iv) the preparation of agenda & all matters ancillary to the meeting of the Board;

(v) the performance of such other functions as may be assigned by the Board; and

(vi) make necessary payments after obtaining approval of the Board.

Functions of the Board.- (1) The Board shall exercise such powers and perform such functions, as may be necessary for carrying out the purposes of this Act.

(2) Without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing sub-section, the Board shall,-

a) set indicators to ascertain a Vulnerable Person;

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cause to conduct a survey from an independent and credible third party to identify the Vulnerable population;

register the Vulnerable population in such manners as may be prescribed by the Board;

fix the amount of Subsistence Allowance- . \_

for Vulnerable Person, per mensem, keeping in view the minimum requirements of food, education of

children and medical treatment, etc.;

communicate the names of Vulnerable Persons to the Accountant General Office for transfer of Subsistence Allowance;

approve the annual budget before 30th

June for each financial year;  
ensure transparency at all levels;

cause to be prepared and laid the annual report to the Assembly, containing details

of its work and activities under this Act;

exercise all the powers for effective control, management and supervision required

under this Act;

to put in place a robust mechanism to

assess the impact of the program; and

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k) redress the grievance of any person who

has not been included as a beneficiary or

who has complaint against any  
beneficiary.

Social Protection Trust Fund.- (1) There shall be

established: a fund to be known as Social Protection

Trust Fund which shall be administered by the Board.

The source of fund shall be,-

i) mandatory deduction from the  
Contributor's basic pay every month at  
such rate as may be prescribed by the  
Board;

ii) grants made by the Government; and

iii) donation received from NGOs,

philanthropists, or any other legal source.

(2) All moneys credited to the Social Protection  
Trust Fund shall be kept in such bank or banks as  
may be prescribed by the Board.

(3) The Accountant General Office shall be the

custodian of the Fund.

Investment Committee.- (1) The Board shall

constitute a committee for investment of amount from  
the Social Protection Trust Fund by vote of majority of  
its members.

(2) Under the general supervision of the Board, the

Investment Committee shall be responsible for

investment of the amounts from the Social Protection

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Trust Funds, on the basis of highest profit rate and in the best interest of Vulnerable Persons.

(3) The accounts of the Social Protection Trust Fund shall be operated jointly by the Secretary Social Welfare and Women Development Department and

Accountant General Azad Jammu and Kashmir.

Disbursement of Allowance.- (1) All the disbursement of the Subsistence Allowance from the Social - -

Protection Trust Fund shall be made by the Accountant General Office through bank accounts or through efficient modern recognized means of disbursement.

(2) The Accountant General Office shall keep the Board informed for all the moneys credited to the Social Protection Trust Fund and disbursed from it on monthly basis.

Audit and Accounts.- (1) All accounts shall be maintained by the Accountant General of Azad Jammu and Kashmir in such manner and form, as the Board may direct.

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(2) All accounts and moneys received in the Social Protection Trust Fund shall be audited annually by the Auditor General of Azad Jammu and Kashmir.

Abuse of Social Assistance.- If in the opinion of the Board a beneficiary abuses his/her social assistance, the Board may suspend payment of social assistance.

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Termination of Social Assistance to Persons wh

are Absent from Azad Jammu and Kashmir.- (1) The  
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Board may terminate payment of social assistance to  
or on behalf of a person who is absent from the State

for a continuous period of six months or longer.

(2) The Board may reinstate the provision of social  
assistance suspended under sub-Section (1), where  
the Board is satisfied that the reasons advanced by the  
applicant justify the reinstatement.

Refund to the Government.- (1) If the Board

approves payment of subsistence allowance in favor of  
a person who was not eligible to receive that payment,  
the amount so paid shall be repayable to the Social  
Protection Trust Fund within three days.

(2) The Board shall recover the amount from the

ineligible person, as provided under sub-section (1),  
and in accordance with the provisions of any other law  
for the time being in force.

(3) | Any person who has provided wrong information

or attestation, as the case may be, shall be guilty of  
offence of furnishing of wrong information under  
Section 177 of Azad Penal Code.

Review of Social Assistance.- The Board shall review

social assistance annually where it has reason to

believe that a significant change in the circumstances  
or beneficiaries have occurred.

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13. Stoppage of Payment.- A Vulnerable Person shall be debarred to receive the Subsistence Allowance in following cases if,-

(i) the Vulnerable Person being a widow or divorced woman enters into another

marriage;

(ii) the Vulnerable Person has submitted false information;

(iii) the Vulnerable Person is an orphan and >

has reached 21 years of age; and/or

(iv) Minimum Standards of Living has been

secured by the Vulnerable Person.

14. Power to make Rules.- The Government may, on the recommendations of Board, make rules for the

purpose of giving effect to the provisions of this Act.

15. Repeal.- The Azad Jammu and Kashmir Subsistence Allowance for Widows and Orphans Act, 2021 (Act XXII of 2021) and the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Social Protection of Vulnerable Population Ordinance, 2024 (Ordinance I of 2024) are hereby repealed.
