

THE AZAD JAMMU AND KASHMIR PROHIBITION OF
INDIAN FILMS ORDER, 1967

(No. H&P/SS/2589-2612/67, Dated 27" April, 1967)

WHEREAS it is necessary in the interest of the security and defence of the State to prohibit the exhibition of Indian films in the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Territory;

Now, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the provisions of section 3 of the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Civil Defence Act, 1951, the Azad Government of the State of Jammu and Kashmir is pleased to make the following Order :-

1. (i) This Order may be called the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Prohibition of Indian Films Order, 1967.

(ii) It extends to the whole of the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Territory;

(iii) It shall come into force at once.

2. No person shall give an exhibition of any Indian film by means of cinematograph in any place in the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Territory.

3. Whoever contravenes the provisions of this Order shall be liable

to be prosecuted under the provisions of the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Civil Defence Act, 1951.
