

THE ADAPTATION OF LAWS RESOLUTION, 1948

Resolution No. 279:- As recommended by the Secretary Law and Order, Azad Kashmir Government in his memorandum dated the 22nd March, 1948, (Appendix 'C') the following enactments will come into force in Azad Kashmir territory as they are in force in the West Punjab and they shall also be deemed to have been in force in the liberated territory as far as practicable and subject to the provisions of any other law for the time being in force :-

1. The Code of Criminal Procedure.
2. The Penal Code.
3. The Evidence Act.
4. The Arms Act.
5. The Code of Civil Procedure.
6. The Police Act.
7. The Shariat Act.
8. The Land Revenue Act.
9. The Tenancy Act.
10. The Courts Act.

Rest of the recommendations contained in the memorandum referred to above (Appendix 'C') from items 3 to 5 are accepted. Immediate effect will be given to all the implications of this Council order. This memorandum so far as its contents are concerned from item 2 to 5 will form part of this Council Order. Recommendation No. 1 as contained in item No. 1 will be considered later on.
