No. 772-777/LD/Leg/93. The following Act of the Assembly received the assent of the president on 12th July, 1993 is hereby published for general information:-

(ACT XXIX of 1993)

ACT

to give effect to the financial proposals of Azad Government of the State of Jammu and Kashmir.

WHEREAS it is expedient to make provisions to give effect to the financial proposals of Azad Government of the State of Jammu and Kashmir and to amend certain laws for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows:-

1. Short title, Extent and Commencement.- (1) This Act may be called the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Finance Act, 1993.

(2) It extends to the whole of Azad Jammu and Kashmir.  
(3) It shall come into force at once.

2. Amendment of Section 3, Act XL of 1986.- In the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Finance Act, 1986 (Act XL of 1986), in Section 3, for sub-section (2), the following shall be substituted, namely:-

"(2) For examination and prescription of animals, the fee shall be

as under:-

(i) vaccine Cattles:- Rupee one per injection.  
(ii) | Vaccine sheep and goats:- Paisa fifty per injection.  
(iii) Vaccine poultry birds:- Paisa ten per injection;  
(iv) Insemination injection cows Rupees twenty per and buffalos:- injection"

3. Amendment of Section 4, Act XVI of 1992. - In the Azad

Jammu and Kashmir Finance Act, 1992 (Act XVI of 1992), in Section 4, in sub-section (12), for clause (b), the following shall be substituted:-

"(b) In case of immovable Rupees eight and a half for property in an Urban every Rupees one hundred or

Area part thereof if the total value of the transaction does not exceed rupees three hundred thousand and rupees ten for every rupees one hundred or part thereof if the total value of the transaction exceeds that amount."
