ACT

to amend further the Azad Jammu & Kashmir legislative Assembly (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges of Members) Act, 1975

WHEREAS it is expedient to provide medical and rest house facilities to members of the Legislative Assembly for the proposes hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows:-

1. Short title and Commencement.- (1) This Act may be called the Azad Jammu & Kashmir Legislative Assembly (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges of the Members) (Amendment) Act, 2004.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. Amendment of Section 2, (Act XX of 1975).- In the Azad Jammu& Kashmir Legislative Assembly (Salaries Allowances and Privileges of the Members) (Amendment) Act, (Act XX of 1975), hereinafter referred to as the 'said Act', after clause (h) of the section 2, semi colon at the end with the word 'and' shall be substituted for full stop and a new clause (j) shall be added as under:-

"q) Ex-Member means a person who has been the elected member of AJ&K legislative Assembly."

3. Addition of Section of 7-B (Act XX of 1975).- In the said Act, after Section 7-A, a new section 7-B shall be added as under.- "7-B. Subject to availability, a Member or Ex Member of the Assembly, on private tours, shall be provided the rest house facility in Azad Jammu & Kashmir on official rates."

4. Amendment of Section 8 (Act XX of 1975).- In Section 8 of the said Act, after the words "a member" the words "or ex member" shall be inserted.

Amendment of section 10- B (Act XX of 1975).- In the said Act, in Section 10-B, for the words "Three hundred thousand" the words " Ten hundred thousand" shall be substituted .
