further to amend the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Legislative Assembly Speaker (Salary, Allowances and Privileges) Act, 1975

WHEREAS, it is expedient further to amend the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Legislative Assembly Speaker (Salary, Allowances and Privileges) Act, 1975 (Act XVII of 1975) in the manner hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows:-

1. Short title and Commencement.-(1) This Act may be called the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Legislative Assembly Speaker (Salary, Allowances and Privileges) (Amendment) Act, 2014.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. Amendment of Section 3, Act XVII of 1975.-In the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Legislative Assembly Speaker (Salary, Allowances and Privileges) Act, 1975 (Act XVII of 1975), hereinafter referred to as the said Act, in Section 3, in sub-section (1) for the words "thirty seven thousand", the words "forty eight thousand" shall be substituted.

3. Amendment of Section 7, Act XVII of 1975.-In the said Act, in Section 7, the words "cars" shall be substituted by the word "vehicles".

4. Amendment of Section 8, Act XVII of 1975.-In the said Act, in Section 8, the word "twenty five thousand" wherever occurring shall be substituted by the words "fifty five thousand".

5. Amendment of Section 11, Act XVII of 1975.-In the said Act, in Section 11,-

(a) for the words "one thousand" the words "three thousand" shall be substituted; and



(b) in the second proviso, after clause (iti) following new clause (iv) shall be inserted:-

“(iv) — while on tour, if accommodation is not available in the rest house and the Speaker stays in the hotel, he shall be paid the actual room rent on production of proper receipt.”
