ACT

further to amend the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Local Government Act, 1990

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Local Government Act, 1990(Act VII of 1990), in the manner hereinafter appearing:

It is hereby enacted as follows:-

1. Short title, Extent_and commencement.-
(1) This Act may be called the Azad Jammu & Kashmir Local Government (Amendment) Act, 2010.

(2) It shall extent to the whole of Azad Jammu & Kashmir.
(3) It shall come into force at once.

2. Amendment of Section 61, Act VII of 1990.-In the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Local Government Act, 1990 (Act VII of 1990), in Section 61, in sub-section (4);

(i) Clauses (a) & (b) shall be substituted as under;

(a) Chairman of the Municipal Committee, Municipal Corporation or Town Committee concerned (Chairman Allotment Committee):

Provided that if there is no elected Chairman of the Committee or corporation, as the case may be, the Administrator or any other person performing the functions of the Chairman shall be the Chairman of the Allotment Committee.

(b) Three members from amongst the elected members of the Committee or Corporation shall be elected by the Committee or Corporation.

(ii) in clause (c) the semicolon shall be substituted by a

colon and thereafter the following proviso shall be added
namely:-

"Provided that the Government may in the
absence of elected members, nominate three other
members from amongst the local residents of Municipal
Corporation or Municipal Committee as the case may
be, for a period specified for such nomination."

Repeal.- The Azad Jammu and Kashmir Local Government
(Amendment) Ordinance, 2010 (Ordinance VI of 2010) is hereby
repealed.
