

THE AZAD JAMMU & KASHMIR MANOEUVRES, FIELD
FIRING AND ARTILLERY PRACTICE ADAPTATION
ACT, 1960.

(ACT XI OF 1960)

(Passed under Government Order No. 513/60 Dated 22-9-1960).

Whereas it is necessary to adapt the Pakistan Manoeuvres, Field Firing and artillery Practice Act, 1938 , in the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Territory, it is hereby enacted as follows :-

1. (i) This Act may be called the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Manoeuvres, Field Firing and Artillery Practice Adaptation Act, 1960.

(ii) It extends to the whole of the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Territory.

(iii) It shall come into force at once.

2. In this Act, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context, the expression :-

(i) 'Government' shall mean the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Government ;

(ii) 'Provincial Government', 'Central Government', or any other expression referring to the Chief executive Government occurring in the Pakistan Manoeuvres, Field Firing and Artillery Practice Act, 1938, or in any rule, notification or order made thereunder, shall be construed to mean 'the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Government.

3. The Pakistan Manoeuvres, Field Firing and Artillery Practice Act, 1938, is adapted by the Government and shall, as far as practicable, apply to and be in force in the Azad Jammu and Kashmir Territory alongwith the rules, notifications and order made thereunder.
