ACT

further to amend the Azad Jammu & Kashmir Ministers (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) Act, 1975

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Azad Jammu & Kashmir Ministers (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) Act, 1975 (Act XVIII of 1975) for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

1. Short title and Commencement.- (1) This Act may be called the Azad Jammu & Kashmir Ministers (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) (Amendment) Act, 2004.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. Addition of Section 7-A, (Act XVIII of 1975)- In the Azad Jammu & Kashmir Ministers (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) Act, 1975 (Act XVIII of 1975), after Section 7, a new Section 7-A shall be added as under:-

“7-A. Any person who has been the elected Prime Minister of Azad Jammu & Kashmir under AJ&K Interim Constitution Act, 1974, shall be entitled to use an official car, services of a driver/gunman and fuel consumption of 400 liters per men sum at Government expense.”

3. Addition of Section 8-A, (Act XVIII of 1975).- In the said Act,

after Section 8, a new Section 8-A shall be added as under:-

“8-A. Any person who has been the elected Prime Minister of Azad Jammu & Kashmir under AJ&K Interim Constitution Act, 1974, shall be entitled to the use of an official residence;

Provided that in case of non-availability of official residence. Ex-Prime Minister shall be paid monthly House Rent not exceeding Rs. 25000/-
