

THE AZAD KASHMIR FOREIGNERS (AMENDMENT)

ACT OF 1953.

(Council Order No. 396/53.)

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Azad Kashmir Foreigners Act of 1952, it is hereby enacted as follows :-

(i) This Act may be called the Azad Kashmir Foreigners

(Amendment) Act of 1953.

(ii) It shall come into force at once and shall apply to the whole of Azad Kashmir territory.

The following shall be added as Sub-Clause 'g' under clause (2) of Section 3 of the Azad Kashmir Foreigners Act of 1952.

"(g) shall be arrested and detained or confined ; and may make provisions for such incidental and supplementary matters as may, in the opinion of the Government, be expedient or necessary for giving effect to this Act."

The following shall be added as sections 14 and 15 of the Azad Kashmir Foreigners Act of 1952.

"14. If any person contravenes the provisions of this Act or of any order made thereunder, or any direction given in pursuance of this Act or such order, he shall be punished with imprisonment ; for a term which may extend to five years and shall also be liable to fine ; and if such person has entered into a bond in pursuance of clause (f) of Sub-section (2) of Section 3, his bond shall be Forfeited, and any person bound thereby shall pay the penalty thereof or show cause to the satisfaction of the convicting court why such penalty should not be paid.

15. No suit, prosecution or other legal proceeding shall lie against any person for anything which is in good faith done or intended to be done under this Act."
