

THE AZAD KASHMIR FOREIGNERS (AMENDMENT)
ORDER OF 1953.

(Passed under Council Order No. 397/53).

The exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Azad, Kashmir Foreigners Act of 1952, the Azad Kashmir Government is pleased to make the following order :-

1. (1) This Order may be called the Azad Kashmir Foreigners (Amendment) Order, 1953.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

(3) It shall extend to the whole of Azad Kashmir Territory.

2. Definition:-

'Order' means the Azad Kashmir Foreigners Order of 1952.

3. In the Order :

(i) In Sub-clause (3) of Clause, 4, Sub-Clauses (3) and (4) of Clause 5, Sub-clause (2) of Clause 8 and in the proviso to Sub-Clause (2) of Clause 9 for the word "rule", wherever it occurs, the word "Clause" and for the word "sub-rule", "sub-

Clause" shall be substituted and

(ii) in Sub-Clauses (2), (3) and (4) of Clause 13 for the word "paragraph", wherever it occurs, the word "Clause", and for the word "Sub-paragraph" the word "sub-clause" shall be substituted.

4. (i) The first proviso to Clause 15 of the Order shall be omitted;

(ii) The word "further" occurring in the second proviso to Clause 15 of the Order shall be omitted.

5. The following two new clauses shall be added after Clause 15 of the order :-

"15-A. A Civil Authority may order that a foreigner shall enter into a bond with or without surities for the due observance of or as an alternative to the enforcement of any or all prescribed or specified restrictions and conditions.

15-B. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Order the Government or any authority authorised by them in this behalf may itself exercise all the powers and functions of a civil Authority in a particular case or class of cases".
