

THE AZAD KASHMIR STAMP DUTY
(AMENDMENT) ACT, 1950

(Passed under Cabinet Resolution No. 47/50)

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Law relating to stamps in

Azad Kashmir it is hereby enacted as follows :-

This Act may be called the Azad Kashmir Stamp Duty
(Amendment) Act of 1950 and it shall come into force forthwith.

Notwithstanding anything contained in the Jammu and Kashmir
Stamp Act of 1977 (Bikirmi) the stamp duty leviable at the time
of the enrolment and admission of Advocates shall be Rs. 250/-;

Provided that the High Court may, with the consultation of
the Finance Department, make a further reduction in each case of
persons seeking admission and enrolment as Advocates if they,
being refugees and also being Jammu and Kashmir state
nationals, are not in a position to pay Rs. 250/-.

Till such time as stamps are printed by the Azad Kashmir
Government stamp duty shall be realized in cash by Courts and
offices in which documents chargeable with duty are presented
and an entry thereof shall be made on such documents by such
Courts and offices.
