

THE AZAD KASHMIR TIMBER PROTECTION  
(AMENDMENT) ACT, 1949

(Passed under Cabinet Resolution No. 239/49)

Subject :- Amendment in the Timber Protection Act, 1948.

Memo : for the Cabinet.

The Chief Conservator of Forests has proposed that an offence under section 7 of the Timber Protection Act of the year 1948 be declared compoundable on the ground that most of the Forest cases have to be compounded on compensation. Hon'able the Revenue Minister has approved the suggestion. The following resolution is therefore drafted for Cabinet sanction :-

"Resolved that an offence under Section 7 of the Azad Kashmir Timber Protection Act of the year 1948 is hereby declared compoundable at the instance of the Forest Department."

Forwarded to the Cabinet Secretary for favour of placing the resolution in the next meeting of the Cabinet.
