ACT
to amend the Bagh Development Authority Act, 1995

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Bagh Development Authority Act, 1995 (XIX of 1995), in the manner hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows:-

1. Short title and Commencement.- (1) This Act may be called the Bagh Development Authority (Amendment) Act, 2001.
(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. Amendment of Section 9, Act XIX of 1995.- In the said Act, subsection (2) of Section 9 shall be omitted.

3. Amendment of Section 16, Act XIX of 1995.- (1) In the said Act:-

(a) in subsection (1) for the words and figure "BPS-19" the words and figure "BPS-16" shall be substituted; and

(b) subsection (2) shall be substituted as under;

"(2) No post in the Authority shall be created without the prior financial concurrence."

4. Amendment of Section 17, Act XIX of 1995.- In the said Act, full stop at the end of Section 17 shall be omitted and thereafter the words "with the prior approval of the Administrative Department" shall be added.

5. Amendment of Section 22, Act XIX of 1995.- In the said Act, in subsection (1) of Section 22 between the words "submit" and "to" the words "within the 1st quarter of every Financial Year" shall be inserted.

6. Amendment of Section 33, Act XIX of 1995.- In the said Act, in Section 33, for the words "fifteen days" the words "ten days" shall be substituted.

Amendment of Section 35, Act XIX of 1995.- In the said Act, in subsection (1) of Section 35, for the words “reasonable opportunity of being heard” the words “ten days notice” shall be substituted.

Repeal.- The Bagh Development Authority (Amendment) Ordinance, 2001 (Ordinance XXXVIII of 2001) is hereby repealed.
