(ACT V OF 1994)

to provide for adaptation and enforcement of the Unani, Ayurvedic and Homoeo Pathic Practitioners Act, 1965

WHEREAS it is necessary and expedient to adapt and to enforce the Unani, Ayurvedic and Homoeo Pathic Practitioners Act, 1965 (Act II of 1965) of Pakistan in the manner hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows:-

Short title and commencement:- (1) This Act may be called the Unani, Ayurvedic and Homoeo Pathic Practitioners (Adaptation) Act, 1993.

(2) It extends to the whole of Azad Jammu and Kashmir.

(3) It shall come into force at once.

Unani, Ayurvedic and Homoeo Pathic Practitioners Act, 1965

to apply to Azad Jammu and Kashmir:- The Unani,

Ayurvedic and Homoeo Pathic Practitioners Act, 1965 (Act II of

1965) hereinafter referred to as the said Act, and all rules made

there under and enforced in Pakistan immediately before the

commencement of this Act shall, as far as practicable, be enforced in Azad Jammu and Kashmir with the following modifications.

(i) The expression "Government of West Pakistan", "Central Government" and "Provincial Government" in the said Act, shall be construed to refer to the Azad Government of the State of Jammu and Kashmir, and the expression "West Pakistan" and "Province" shall be

construed to refer to Azad Jammu and Kashmir.

(ii) All other expressions occurring in the said Act shall have the same meaning as are assigned to them under the said Act.

Repeal:- The Unani, Ayurvedic and homoeo Pathic Practitioners

(Adaptation) Ordinance, 1993 (Ordinance L of 1993) is hereby

repealed.
