An Act further to amend the Representation of the People Act, 1976

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Representation of the People
Act, 1976 (LXXXV of 1976), for the purpose hereinafter appearing ;

It is hereby enacted as follows :—

1, Short title and commencement.—(1) This Act may be called the
Representation of the People (Seventh Amendment) Act, 1985.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. Amendment of section 64, Act LXXXV of 1976.—In the Representation
of the People Act, 1976 (LXXXV of 1976), in section 64, after the word
"sections", the figure and comma " 476," shall be inserted.

3. Repeal—The Representation of the People (Seventh Amendment) Ordi-
nance, 1985 (XXIV of 1985), is hereby repealed.

5. Substitution of section 9, Act XXVII of 1974.—In the said Act, for section 9 the following shall be substituted, namely :—

“9. Housing allowance—A member shall be paid a housing allowance at the rate of three hundred rupees for each day during any period of residence on duty.”

6. Amendment of section 10, Act XXVII of 1974.—In the said Act, in section 10,—

(a) in sub-section (1), for the words “six thousand and six hundred Rupees”, twice occurring, the words “fifteen thousand rupees” shall be substituted; and

(b) in sub-section (2), for the words “four thousand and two hundred rupees bears to the sum of six thousand and six hundred rupees” the words “ten thousand rupees bears to the sum of fifteen thousand rupees” shall be substituted.

7. Substitution of section 11, Act XXVII of 1974.—In the said Act, for section 11 the following shall be substituted, namely :—

“11. Telephone—A member shall be entitled to have a telephone installed at his residence at Government expenses where facilities for installation are available and to a monthly allowance of five hundred rupees on account of telephone charges, whether a telephone is so installed or not.”

8. Insertion of new section 11A, Act XXVIII of 1974.—In the said Act, after section 11, amended as aforesaid, the following new section shall be inserted, namely :—

“11A. Office maintenance allowance—A member shall be entitled to receive an office maintenance allowance at the rate of seven hundred and fifty rupees per mensem.”

9. Addition of new section 14A, Act XXVII of 1974.—In the said Act, after section 14, the following new section shall be added, namely :—

“14A. Act to have effect Subject to instructions, etc.—This Act shall have effect subject to such instructions, rules, exceptions, further concessions or easements as the Federal Government may from time to time issue or grant.”

It is hereby enacted as follows ; —

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) This Act may be called the Modaraba Companies and Modaraba (Floatation and Control) (Second Amendment) Act, 1985,

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. Amendment of section 5, Ordinance XXXI of 1980.—In the Modaraba Companies and Modaraba (Floatation and Control) Ordinance, 1980 (XXXI of 1980), in section 5, in clause (b), for the words “five million” the words “two and a half million” shall be substituted.

An Act further to amend the Employee's Cost of Living (Relief) Act, 1973

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Employees' Cost of Living (Relief) Act, 1973 (I of 1974), for the purpose hereinafter appearing ;

It is hereby enacted as follows :—

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) This Act may be called the Employees' Cost of Living (Relief) (Amendment) Act, 1985.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. Amendment of section 3, Act I of 1974.—In the Employees' Cost of Living (Relief) Act, 1973 (I of 1974), in section 3,—

(a) in sub-section (5), in the Explanation, after the word “ sub-section ”, the words, brackets and figure “and sub-section (6)” shall be

(b) after sub-section (5), amended as aforesaid, the following new sub-section shall be added, namely :—

“(6) In addition to the cost of living allowance admissible under sub-sections (1), (2), (3) and (4), or, as the case may be, sub-section (5), if any, every employee whose wages do not exceed one thousand five hundred rupees shall, in respect of his employment on or after the first day of July, 1985, whether on time-work or piece-work basis, be paid by his employer an increase in wages at the rate of 13.5 per cent of his wages :

Provided that the said increase in wages shall be set off—

(a) against the amount payable as a relief due to rise in the cost of living under an agreement or settlement reached, or an award given, under the Industrial Relations Ordinance,

1969 (XXIII of 1969), which has been announced and be-

come effective on or after the first day of January, 1984; and
